HAWKINS ISD FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

GENERAL INFORMATION

What is Coronavirus (COVID19)?

Coronavirus (COVID-19) is a new virus that causes respiratory illness in people and can spread from person to person. The virus that causes COVID-19 originated in Wuhan, Hubel Province China. It is being closely monitored by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

Are there any confirmed cases of COVID 19 in HISD?

HISD currently has no confirmed cases of COVID-19. However, acting out of an abundance of caution, the district issued a 14-day self-quarantine for several individuals, all of whom recently returned from a country on the CDC travel warning list or are closely related to someone who did. Schools will be identified if cases are confirmed, as recommended by health officials.

What are the symptoms?

Symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath

How is the virus spread? Is there a vaccine?

COVID-19 is spread between people who are in close contact with one another (within about six feet) through coughing and sneezing. The virus also may be transmitted by touching an object or surface with the virus on it, then touching your mouth, nose, or eyes before washing your hands. There is currently no vaccine to protect against COVID-19.

What can I do to prevent the spread of the virus?

- Wash hands with soap and water frequently for at least 20 seconds
- Use alcohol-based sanitizers when soap and water are not available
- Use disposable tissues when coughing and sneezing, and dispose of them carefully and promptly
- If tissues are not available, direct your cough or sneeze into the crook of your arm/sleeve
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
- Clean and disinfect “high-touch” objects and surfaces
- Stay home when you are sick, and remain home until you have been fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication
- Avoid close contact with anyone who has cold or flu-like symptoms
- Maintain healthy habits that support your immune system

How long will HISD be closed due to COVID19?

We are committed to keeping you updated and providing you with information as soon as we have it. Please know that the health and safety of our students and staff is our top priority and all decisions are being made with that in mind. We are continuing to closely monitor the situation and staying in contact with city, state, and national health and education officials.

How are we keeping schools clean?

HISD is enhancing standard procedures for cleaning and disinfection of schools. In addition to routine cleaning, custodial crews are regularly disinfecting tables, chairs, desks, cabinets, door handles, restrooms, sinks, water fountains, and other frequently touched areas, as suggested by local and state health officials and the Texas Education Agency. We are using guidance from the Center for Disease Control (CDC) regarding approved sanitizers to use for COVID-19.

What will the district do if someone at a school or office is diagnosed with COVID19?

If both exposure and symptoms of fever or respiratory illness are present, the nurse is instructed to inform the principal, isolate the individual, and contact health services for additional guidance. Where necessary, cleaning and disinfection will take place in accordance with Dept of Environmental Health Services Standard Operating Procedures.

AT HOME LEARNING GUIDELINES (Depending on extended closures)

As HISD responds to the challenges of COVID-19, we are prepared to support you and your children through this time by providing academic and nutritional outreach.

Hawkins ISD is launching Camp R.O.C.K. - a virtual school for all students PK-12th enrolled in Hawkins ISD. This is an opportunity for students to receive grade-level instruction and meals from the comfort of their home until it is feasible to return to HISD classrooms. Our goal is to create a sense of normalcy and routine until we can return to campus.

Our administration and teaching staff value and need your continued support and flexibility as we launch this program to support our students. We ask that you partner with HISD as your child's *Camp R.O.C.K. Learning Coach*.

Our teachers will provide instructional resources weekly for your children. As Learning Coach, we are asking you to coach and support students with completing assignments, common questions, and logistics of our virtual program.

ADMINISTRATION ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Monitor COVID-19 Updates and Adjust Program As Necessary
- Communicate with HISD Family current validated information
- Coordinate and Oversee Camp R.O.C.K. program
- Respond to rock@hawkinsisd.org incoming questions
- Post daily/weekly updates on social media, news outlets, and HISD communication mediums
- Attest to TEA instruction is continuing during school closure

TEACHER ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Supply and Support daily instruction to all students
- Respond to student and parents in a timely fashion on instructional questions
- Support district efforts for communicating program updates and changes
- Deliver instruction via packets, internet, and other means
- Grade and monitor student progress

CAMP ROCK LEARNING COACH/ PARENT OR CAREGIVER ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Review emails, social media, and website postings daily for updates on the situation
- Support students at home with understanding instructions for school on assignments and work packets/projects.
- Ensure a timely return of any materials provided for in-home use
- Communicate with teachers and staff as needed to support learning
- Create daily routines for students working from home
- Offer encouragement for students as they process the situation

COMMUNITY MEMBERS ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Review emails, social media, and website postings daily for updates on the situation
- Support efforts to flatten the curve
- Donate supplies or internet use to students in need
- Maintain social distancing and cancel events
- Continue implementing recommendations from local, state, and national government recommendations for handwashing and hygiene
